Speaker: **Melissa White, AICP, Senior Planner, SSFM International, Inc. and Dre Kalili, City & County of Honolulu Department of Transportation Services**

Topic: **Going Macro on Micromobility**

Melissa May White is a senior planner with SSFM International in Honolulu, Hawaii. She specializes in bringing together community, agency, and technical stakeholders and expertise to create and implement shared visions for healthy, resilient, and sustainable communities. Her focus areas include multimodal transportation, long-range community planning, placemaking, and resilience planning across the State of Hawaii. Her projects have included development of the County of Hawaii's Complete Streets Program, public engagement for the launch and first three projects of the City and County of Honolulu Complete Streets Program, and multimodal planning efforts for communities including Downtown Hilo and Waimea on Hawaii Island.

Dre Kalili is an executive assistant at the Department of Transportation Services and advises on policy, legislative strategy, and business development. Since joining DTS in January 2019, she has drafted and advocated for legislation on shared mobility, revenue enhancement opportunities, and Honolulu's future integrated bus-rail transit system. Dre comes to DTS from the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation Harbors Division where she was responsible for revamping the port tariffs, maximizing the value of underused facilities, supporting new uses of harbor facilities, establishing Hawaii's first marine highway route designation to compete for federal funds, and authorizing transportation network companies operations at the airports.

Presentation Highlights:

- Share key takeaways from a panel discussion she facilitated in August 2019 that explored the evolving landscape of micromobility and its integration into cities.
- The discussion provided insights into the dynamics between public and private entities in the transportation realm, and a glimpse into what the streetscape of the future might look like.
